RIGHT HIP

There is a fracture through the right femoral neck. There is also evidence of intertrochanteric fracture of the right hip. No other joint or other soft tissue abnormalities.

IMPRESSION: Intertrochanteric fracture of the right hip. There also appears to be a fracture of the right femoral neck.

PELVIS

A bipolar left hip prosthesis is noted in place. There is an intertrochanteric fracture of the right hip. There also appears to be a nondisplaced fracture through the right femoral neck. No other joint or soft tissue abnormalities.

IMPRESSION: Intertrochanteric fracture of the right hip. There is also evidence of a nondisplaced fracture through the right femoral neck.
